Provided 8,289 individuals with necessary follow-up services they would not have been able to receive without Prevent Blindness Texas

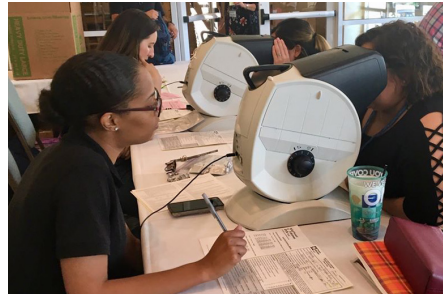
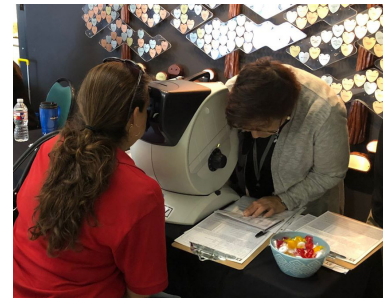
Screened over 32,015 children and adults

The **FASKEN FOUNDATION** funding allowed PBT to significantly expand our children's programming in the Greater Permian Basin area. Their generous support made it possible to expand our vision screening outreach by serving more than 4,000 children this past year. Their continued investment in our programs has also allowed PBT to expand program capacity by certifying 29 community volunteers serving the Permian Basin community. These volunteers are not only ensuring sustainability and community ownership of our screening program, but they are helping PBT provide increased accessibility of eye care services to better serve medically underserved children.

**VALERO** has been a long-standing partner that has actively supported many endeavors in our Southwest Region. From sponsoring our Walk to investing in our children's programs, they make a difference in the community we serve. Last year, we doubled the number of Walk participants in San Antonio. It is in partnership with incredible sponsors like Valero that we can grow and have even more impact in the community. They are strategic and committed partners that make a difference for PBT and our clients

The team at **ESSILOR** has been instrumental in supporting Prevent Blindness Texas in many capacities. Last year, we were fortunate to have Essilor participate in our Dark Dining event in Dallas, have a team at the Houston Walk and provide support for our Golf Tournament. They were one of our top partners for the year. Their investment in the community goes beyond events though, as we have two board members affiliated with Essilor, and they are deeply committed to our mission.

The **WOMEN WELLNESS (WOW) PROGRAM**, led by Dr. Carol Robazetti, has partnered with PBT to integrate vision and eye health activities with their coordinated women's health community outreach events providing free cervical and breast and cervical cancer screening events to uninsured or underinsured women in the Greater Houston area. Through these events, we are joining our efforts for comprehensive health promotion efforts by providing access to vision and eye health services through vision screenings, eye health education, and eye care resources to program participants as they wait for their health exams. The integration of our vision and eye health activities with those of the WOW Program are essential for addressing the significant barriers to fundamental changes required to ensure that the overall vision and health needs for this target population are being met. In 2019 alone, we provided certified vision screenings to 339 female participants at these eye health screenings, of which 84% and 71% were referred for risk factors and visual acuity, respectively.
